DEEPAK GUPTA, J.(Oral)

By way of this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for his release on regular bail in a case arising out of FIR No.1 dated 17.07.2022, under Sections 120-B, 406, 419, 420, 506 of IPC (Sections 467, 468, 471 and 386 of IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Cyber Crime, Sonipat, District Sonipat.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the matter has already been compromised between the parties; that even the quashing petition bearing CRM-M-2373-2024, titled as ***“Mohd. Rizwan and others v. State of Haryana and another”***, was filed, in which statement of parties have already been recorded regarding the compromise and; that petition is fixed for today itself. That petition has been allowed vide a separate order of today itself and in that petition, FIR in question qua present petitioner has been quashed.

3. Learned State counsel could not refute the aforesaid contention and even counsel for the complainant has also no objection to

grant bail to the petitioner. He has also conceded the factum of compromise effected between the parties and that the FIR qua the petitioner has already been quashed.

4. In view of the aforesaid factual position, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, petitioner is admitted to bail. He is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
