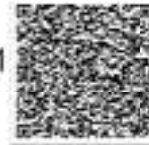

The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari to set aside order dated 24.09.2015 (Annexure P-5) passed by the learned Superintending Canal Officer, Patiala Circle, IB Patiala and order dated 09.12.2014 (Annexure P-2) passed by the learned Divisional Canal Officer, Mansa Division, IB Jawaharke.

2. A perusal of file reveals that on the last date of hearing

(25.04.2024), the following order was passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court:-

“No steps have been taken for impleading the legal representatives of the petitioner.

To come up on 10.09.2024.

Let the needful be done on or before the next date of hearing.”
