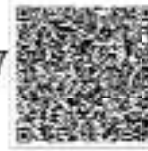

HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside order dated 28.01.2011 (Annexure P-3) passed by the learned District Collector, Ludhiana; order dated 19.02.2013 (Annexure P-5) passed by the learned Commissioner, Patiala and impugned order dated 22.02.2018 (Annexure P-8) passed by the learned Financial Commissioner (Appeals), Punjab.

2. Learned counsel for respondent No.4 informs the Court that the instant matter pertains to the appointment of Lambardar of Village Mukandpur and respondent No.4 (Shingara Singh) was appointed as Lambardar by all the revenue authorities. Learned counsel further submits that since the petitioner (Gurmit Singh) has expired, therefore, the present

writ petition has become infructuous as no further cause of action survives in the same.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for respondent No.4, the present writ petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
