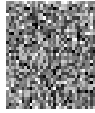

The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to promote the petitioners by considering them at par with respondent no.6, who is junior to them.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the second respondent. At this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case the second respondent is directed to decide their pending representations, Annexures P-4 to 6, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. R.S. Budhwar, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent/State, and submits that the pending representations, will be decided by the second respondent expeditiously.

5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the second respondent, to consider and decide the pending representations, Annexure P-4 to 6, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of three months from receiving a certified copy of this order.

6. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹25,000 to the petitioners.
