The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.298 dated 26.07.2023 under Sections 420, 120-B and 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Matlauda, District Panipat.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim orders dated 16.10.2023 and 03.11.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the orders dated 16.10.2023 and 03.11.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.
