The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider the service rendered by the petitioner from the date of her initial appointment for grant of pensionary benefits alongwith all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the second respondent. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the second respondent is directed to decide her pending legal notice, dated 01.05.2024, Annexure P-4, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. R.S. Budhwar, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents/State and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 01.05.2024, will be decided by the second respondent expeditiously.

5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the second respondent-Director General Higher Education, Haryana, to consider and decide the pending

legal notice, dated 01.05.2024, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of three months from receiving a certified copy of this order.

6. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹25,000 to the petitioner.
