The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for quashing of order dated 15.04.2024 passed by learned Additional Session Judge, Fatehabad in NDPS -92-2021 titled as "State Vs. Raj Kumar Etc." in case arising out of FIR No.106 dated 03.03.2021 registered under Section 22 (b) of Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station City Fatehabad whereby benefit of bail extended to the petitioners had been cancelled and bonds were forfeited to the State and warrants of arrest had been issued against them. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that on 18.09.2023 due to inadvertence they noted some wrong date qua the trial that is why they could not appear on 15.04.2024, as a result of which, their bail was cancelled. It is submitted that their absence was not intentional. They are ready to join the proceedings. It is therefore, urged by the learned counsel that one more opportunity may be granted to them to appear before

the learned trial Court and the impugned order be set aside. Keeping in view the submission as made in the petition and in the interest of justice, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to surrender before the learned trial Court within a period of one month from today and on their surrender, learned trial Court shall admit them on bail subject to their furnishing personal/surety bonds to its satisfaction. However, if they fail to do so, the petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
