1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the respondents for conducting thorough investigation in General Diary No.14 dated 27.06.2023 registered at Police Station Shimlapuri, Ludhiana as cognizable offence has been committed in a proper and fair manner.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner *inter alia* contends that in spite of the fact that the husband of the petitioner has made a statement before the concerned jurisdictional police authorities on 27.06.2023, no action has been taken so far.
3. Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who appears on advance, submits that the matter is being investigated, as initially the husband of the petitioner had made a statement at the time of death of his son that no person is at fault and the local police has initiated proceedings under Section 174 Cr.P.C. vide General Diary No.14 dated 27.06.2023 registered at Police Station

Shimlapuri, District Ludhiana. Thereafter, on 17.08.2023, the petitioner has produced suicide note of the deceased, veracity of which is being verified and proper action shall be taken after conclusion of the investigation.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this Court find no ground to issue any direction as prayed for by the petitioner in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.
