CM-3558-LPA-2024

This is an application under Order XXII Rule 2, 3 and 11 of the Code of Civil Procedure for bringing on record the legal representatives of late Janki (appellant No.12), who is stated to have passed away on 31.10.2018.

For the reasons set out in the application, which are duly supported by an affidavit, the same is allowed, subject to all just exceptions. Consequently, LR's of the deceased as depicted in paragraph 3 of the application are brought on record for the purpose of pursuing the present appeal only.

Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

CM-3560-LPA-2024

Application is allowed as prayed for and Annexures AX-1 and AX-2, are taken on record.

CM-3561-LPA-2024

Vide this application, applicants-appellants No.12, 13 and 15, wish to withdraw the appeal.



For the reasons set out in the application, which are duly supported by an affidavit, the same is allowed. Consequently, applicants-appellants No.12, 13 and 15, are permitted to withdraw the appeal.

CM-3559-LPA-2024

For the reasons set out in the application which are duly supported by an affidavit, the same is allowed. Accordingly, the appeal is taken on Board for hearing.

LPA-658-2012 (O&M)

Learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana submits that since vide CM-3136-LPA-2017, appellants No.1 to 6 had prayed for withdrawal of the appeal, the same was granted vide order dated 11.08.2017. Similarly, he submits that vide another CM-3177-LPA-2017, appellants No.7 and 8, had sought to withdraw the appeal and the prayer was granted. Consequently, the appeal, on their behalf, was ordered to be withdrawn, on 11.08.2017. Likewise, it is submitted that vide CM-2776-LPA-2021, moved by appellants No.9, 10, 11 and 14, had prayed for withdrawal of the appeal and the prayer was granted on 15.02.2022. Further, appellants No.12, 13 and 15 have been permitted to withdraw the appeal, vide order of an even date. That being so, none of the appellants survive to pursue the matter.

In the wake of the position sketched out above, the appeal is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
