 As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant and representative of the respondent Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹75,000/- over and above, the amount awarded by the learned Tribunal is allowed to the appellant, as full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant-Ranbir.

 Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque/demand draft amounting to ₹75,000/- in the name of appellant-Ranbir, within a period of thirty days from receipt of certified copy of this order, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 6% per annum shall follow on this amount till its realization. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque/demand draft from the learned counsel/representative of the respondent Insurance Company. The appellant(s) counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque/demand draft from the office of the Lok Adalat.
