In the present petition, the challenge is to the Punjab Ad hoc. ,
Contractual, Daily Wage, Temporary, Work Charged and Outsourced
Employee's Welfare Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the same has
already been re-appealed.

Learned State counsel further submits that the implementation
of the said Act has already been stayed keeping in view the direction given
by this Court in CWP No.4187 of 2017 titled "***Anika Gupta Vs. State of
Punjab***".

The said averment raised on behalf of the learned State counsel
have gone unrebutted at the hands of the petitioners keeping in view the fact

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that Punjab Ad hoc., Contractual, Daily Wage, Temporary, Work Charged and Outsourced Employee's Welfare Act, 2016 has already been re-appealed and further, there is already a direction by the Division Bench of this Court not to implement the same hence, no relief as being claim in the present petition can be extended to the prayer of the petitioners.

Hence, the present petition stands dismissed.
