Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.265 dated 02.07.2024 registered under Sections 406, 420 of IPC at Police Station City Dabwali, District Sirsa.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties and further the petitioner has joined investigation with the police by virtue of the previous order dated 08.08.2024 passed by this Court.

3. Counsel appearing on behalf of complainant has produced one compromise deed dated 23.09.2024 and submits that parties have entered into compromise and that the complainant party is having no objection, if the present petition is allowed.



4. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ravinder Kumar submits that petitioner who has already joined the investigation is not required by the police for any further investigation in the present case.

5. In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 08.08.2024 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
