Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as well as his workers so that the order allotted to him vide communication dated 16.07.2024 (P-1) can be executed.

2. This Court on 09.08.2024 passed the following order:-

“Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent no.4 shall look into the complaint/representation dated 20.07.2024 (P-3) submitted by the petitioner, in accordance with law.”

3. In pursuance of the aforesaid order, learned State counsel, on instructions, apprise the Court that required security have already been provided to the petitioner for execution of the work in question.

4. In view of above development, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not press the present petition, at this stage and the same be disposed off.

5. Ordered accordingly.

6. However, it is clarified that, if, an occasion so arises, petitioner would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
