1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to redress the grievance of the petitioners with regards to the National Highway No. 44 near village Rai, District Sonapat.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as regards their grievances mentioned in the petition, they have already sent a representation dated 02.08.2024 (Annexure P-2) and they would be satisfied in case respondent No.4 is directed to consider and decide the said representation by passing a well reasoned and speaking order in a time bound manner.

With the consent of the parties, the present petition is accordingly **disposed of** without commenting on the merits of the present case and with a direction to respondent No.4-The Project Director, National Highways Authority of India, Project Implementation Unit-Sonipat, to take note of the representation dated 02.08.2024 (Annexure P-2) sent by the petitioners and to pass a well reasoned and speaking order thereupon after granting an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties in accordance with law expeditiously and preferably within a period of 04 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
