Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 17.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed representation (Annexure P-2) dated 16.07.2024 to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Rupnagar raising his grievance as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2– Senior Superintendent of Police, District Rupnagar to decide the aforementioned representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.



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4. Mr. R.S. Thind, DAG Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice for the official respondents. Counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply a copy of complete paper book to the counsel appearing for the State during the course of the day.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforementioned representation dated 16.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner expeditiously, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
