Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing the Rule 6.17 (3) of Punjab Civil Service Rules (Volume-II) (as amended in 2016) (Annexure P-8A), communication dated 15.06.2017 (Annexure P-6) as well as subsequent order dated 13.09.2018 (Annexure P-7), whereby claim of the petitioner for family pension has been rejected.
