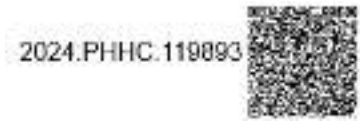

Prayer in this writ petition filed by the petitioners under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing the order dated 22.10.2020 (Annexure P-26) passed by respondent No.2, during the pendency of CWP No.17191 of 2020, filed by the petitioners. Further a writ of mandamus has been sought for directing the respondents to allow the petitioners to work on the basis of their regular appointment order(s) dated 29.12.2016 and 03.01.2017 (Annexures P-11 to P-11/Z) and to grant regular pay scale of Rs.10300-34800+4400 Grade Pay, all allowances and all other service benefits to the petitioners in terms of regular appointment orders. Another prayer has been made to stay the operation and implementation of impugned order dated 22.10.2020 (Annexure P-26), passed by respondent No.2, during the pendency of the writ petition.



Learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action, so as to challenge the order dated 16.02.2021, whereby the order of regularization has been withdrawn.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

Pending applications, if any, are also stands disposed of, accordingly.
