1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing order dated 02.08.2022 passed by Additional District Magistrate, Kurukshetra in case No.61/DC/5/2021 filed on 11.11.2021 (Annexure P-4)
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has no objection to respondent No. 3 staying in the house but the petitioner should also be permitted to stay in the house owned by her.
3. Learned counsel for respondent No. 3 has submitted that she has no objection to the said course of action and she has never restrained the petitioner from coming into the house in question but prays that respondent No. 3 be not evicted from the said house.

4. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances and the statements made on behalf of the petitioner and the contesting respondent No. 3, the present petition is disposed of in view of the said statements. The petitioner and respondent No. 3 would be bound by the statements made on their behalf before this Court.
