1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order dated 03.06.2024 (Annexure P-2) wherein the respondents have declined his prayer for grant of 08 weeks parole on the ground of presumption.

2. Learned counsel at the outset has drawn the attention of this Court to the impugned order dated 03.06.2024 annexed as Annexure P-2 passed by respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Magistrate, SAS Nagar, vide which his request for grant of parole was declined on account of the Lok Sabha Elections. Learned counsel has submitted that since the Lok Sabha Elections have concluded, there is no hindrance to the petitioner being granted parole, as had been prayed by him. Learned counsel submits that he would file a fresh application for being released on parole before respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Magistrate, SAS Nagar and the official respondents be directed to decide it expeditiously.

3. In view of the restricted prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Magistrate, SAS Nagar to decide the application, as and when, if any, moved by the petitioner seeking his release on parole, at the earliest, in accordance with law.
