1. Prayer in this revision petition is for setting aside the impugned order dated 16.07.2024 passed by the learned Civil Judge, Junior Division, Ludhiana, whereby the application filed by the respondents/defendants for leading additional evidence and to examine handwriting expert has been allowed.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer to issue directions to the learned Trial Court to conclude the evidence of the handwriting expert, which remains to be examined by the respondents/defendants on the scheduled date of hearing i.e. 05.09.2024. Learned counsel while referring to the order dated 16.07.2024 submits that single opportunity was afforded to the respondents/defendants to present their evidence of handwriting expert. However, more than one opportunity has been provided to do so.
3. Given the limited prayer, the issuance of notice to the respondents is dispensed with.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and with his able assistance, have gone through the paper-book.

5. In view of the above and limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Trial Court is directed to conclude the evidence of the respondents/defendants with respect to the handwriting expert on the date of hearing scheduled before the trial Court i.e. 05.09.2024. It is made clear that no further undue adjournment should be given to the respondents/defendants in this regard.

6. It is to be noted that concept of right to speedy trial focuses on expeditious case resolution to enhance the efficacy and credibility of judiciary.

7. Needless to mention, parties to the case shall assist the Court in expeditious disposal of the case.

8. In view of the above, this revision petition stands disposed of accordingly.

9. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
