AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

Petitioner has filed instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for issuance of direction to official respondent Nos.2 to 4 to protect his life and liberty from the hands of private respondent Nos.5 to 13.

2. Petitioner had sought protection from his own family members including his mother Kamaljit Kaur respondent No.5 and wife Ramandeep Kaur respondent No.9. After procuring presence of aforesaid parties, matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre vide order dated 30.08.2024. Matter remained pending before Mediation and Conciliation Centre till date but no report has been received. Again there is request for extension of time.

3. Today, petitioner has not appeared in person. Though his counsel is present. Respondent Nos.5 and 9 i.e. mother and wife of petitioner are present in the Court, who confirmed that petitioner has returned home on 12.10.2024. This fact clearly indicates that matter is reconciled. As far now petitioner has no threat perception.

4. In light of this, no further direction is required and present petition stands disposed of.

5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
