1. Petitioners Simran Kaur and Gurpreet Singh are present in Court. It is confirmed that Simran Kaur petitioner No. 1 is a minor who has studied up to 12th class. She alleged that she was beaten up in the house. She was forced to do work but she wanted to continue with her studies. On query, she disclosed that she will take admission in a college in future and petitioner No. 2 is going to help her. It is further discovered that petitioner No. 2 Gurpreet Singh is allegedly involved in four criminal cases, in which he claims that in one of the case, he has been acquitted. However, some cases are under NDPS Act.

Petitioner No. 1, being minor cannot be kept in company of petitioner No. 2. It will be appropriate to send petitioner No. 1 Simran Kaur at Gandhi Vanita Ashram, Jalandhar.

At this stage, petitioner No. 1 started saying that she is not feeling well. Considering this, she is sent to Dispensary available in this High Court for her treatment under the security of L/Ct. Pawandeep Kaur.

Right now, respondent No. 4 Jaswinder Kaur (mother of petitioner No. 1) has not reached the Court. Learned counsel for respondents No. 4 and 5 is

requesting for pass over.

At his request, pass over is allowed. File will be taken up on arrival of respondent No. 4-Jaswinder Kaur (mother of petitioner No. 1), so that matter is referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre with the consent of both sides to explore the possibility of compromise.

Case is passed over.

Mr. Vikram Preet Arora, Advocate filed his Vakalatnama on behalf of respondents No. 4 and 5, which is taken on record.

Respondent No. 4 Jaswinder Kaur – mother of petitioner No. 1 stated that she is ready to take the custody of her daughter Simran Kaur along with assurance that she will not be beaten up or ill treated in the house. However, Simran Kaur – petitioner No. 1 is not ready to accompany her mother. She insisted that she will be beaten up in the house. Under these circumstances, matter could not be sent to Mediation and Conciliation Centre.

Considering the aforesaid factual position, Simran Kaur who is minor, age around 17 years is sent to Children Home, Gandhi Vanita Ashram, Jalandhar for safe custody. Her custody is handed over to L/Ct. Pawandeep Kaur, No. 713/FGS along with ASI Lakhvir Singh, No. 459/FGS for taking her to Gandhi Vanita Ashram, Jalandhar till further orders.

So far as petitioner No. 2 is concerned, in case he has any threat perception from the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 11, he can file

representation before respondent No. 3, who will take adequate steps, considering threat perception.

This order will not have any effect on any legal action taken as per law.

Petition is accordingly, disposed of.
