The prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to the official respondent Nos. 2 to 7 to grant police protection to the petitioners and to execute the order 01.04.2021 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Jagraon whereby petitioner No.1 and her minor son were allowed to reside on the first floor of the shared house of private respondents.

Referring to the status report, learned State counsel has informed that in compliance of the said order SHO, Police Station Jodhan has summoned both the parties and it was noticed that in-laws family of petitioner No.1 has no residential house at village Dolon. As such, the residential accommodation could not be provided to the petitioners.

However, learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Jagraon has re-considered
