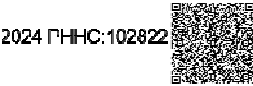

1. Instant petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking writ of *mandamus*, directing the respondents to grant interest @ 12% for the delayed payments on retiral dues in view of the Full Bench judgment in *A.S. Radhawa v. State of Punjab, 1997(3) R.S.J. 318*.
2. Perusal of the file shows that the petitioner has approached this Court without making a demand for grant of interest on the retiral dues to the respondents.
3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw this petition with liberty to file a detailed representation within a period of four weeks from today and prays that the same may directed to be considered and disposed of in a time-bound manner.



4. Ms. Saguna Arora, AAG, Punjab, who has appeared on receipt of advance copy of the petition, has no objection to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file a representation with the respondents, as aforesaid. If any such representation is submitted by the petitioner within a period of four weeks, same shall be considered and disposed of by respondent No.5 within a period of three months thereafter. In case, the petitioner is found entitled, necessary benefits be released within a period of one month thereafter.
