Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India *inter alia* for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside impugned order dated 21.06.2024, Annexure P-1, passed by respondent No.3, whereby the depot license issued to the petitioner under the Punjab Targeted Public Distribution System (Licensing & Control) Order, 2016, was suspended.
2. State counsel has placed on record a copy of order dated 17.09.2024 passed by the Licensing Authority to submit that the suspension has been revoked and a fine of Rs.2500/- has been imposed upon the petitioner, which he has duly deposited.
3. In view of the above development, petition has become infructuous.
4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
