NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing the order dated 31.01.2017 (Annexure P-8), passed by respondent No.1, whereby the petitioner has been reverted to the post of Auction Recorder from the post of Mandi Supervisor.

2. While issuing notice of motion on 06.03.2017, it was ordered that the effect of the impugned order is stayed. In the meanwhile, the petitioner has retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 31.05.2022.

3. Learned counsel for respondents No.1 & 2 submits that all the pensionary dues of the petitioner have been released to him by linking the same with the present writ petition.

4. Since the petitioner has already retired from service and his pensionary benefits have been released, therefore, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.
