1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for quashing of FIR No.207 dated 28.06.2020, under Section 420, 120-B IPC, and, under Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professional Act, registered at Police Station Kapurthala, District Kapurthala alongwith all consequential proceedings enumerating therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 02.08.2023 (Annexure P-2).
2. The notice was issued by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court on dated 16.08.2023, however, respondent No. 2 has not been served till date, as petitioner has not filed the requisite process fee.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits he has no instructions towards the compromise *inter-se* the parties.
4. It seems that there is no compromise effected between the parties, therefore, the instant petition is ordered to be **dismissed**, however, with liberty to the petitioner to re-access this Court on the same cause of action in case a full compromise is effected between the parties.
