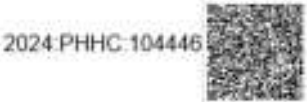

1. The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing official respondents to initiate the appropriate proceedings against private respondents for illegally usurping various grants issued to Gram Panchayat from time to time.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to pursue his remedies before the Department of Rural Development & Panchayats; Punjab.
3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
