1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the order dated 31.05.2021 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.2, whereby the petitioner has been forcibly retired from service on attaining the age of 58 years.

2. The petitioner has also filed an application bearing CM-5182-CWP-2024 under Order 6 Rule 17 read with Section 151 of CPC as well as Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking amendment in the head note (a), (b) and para 6 as well as in the prayer clause of the petition.

3. After arguing the case for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the instant petition and also application filed under Order 6 Rule 17 read with Section 151 of CPC



seeking amendment in the petition, with liberty to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action with better particulars.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
