1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for issuance of a mandamus upon the official respondents not to harass and humiliate the petitioner at the instance of private respondent No.6 by initiating repeated inquiries on the false and frivolous complaints.

2. In response to the notice issued by this Court, reply has been filed by the State on 21.3.2024. As per the reply, no complaint is pending against the present petitioner, before the police of Abohar, District Fazilka and further-more one other FIR No. 148 dated 16.6.2022, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC was registered against the petitioner, which was found to be false. The relevant para reads as under:-

“That it is submitted that at present, no application/complaint is pending before the police against the petitioner and the petitioner is not required by the police in any enquiry. It is submitted that an FIR No. 148 dated 16.6.2022, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC was registered against the petitioner at P.S. City-1, Abohar. During the investigation, the said FIR was found to be false.”

3. In view of specific stand taken by the State, no direction is required to be passed in the instant petition, therefore, the instant petition is ordered to be closed.
