The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for conducting
fair investigation in case bearing FIR No.259 dated 11.09.2021 under Sections
363/366-A of IPC registered at Police Station Focal Point, Police
Commissionerate Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the
daughter of the petitioner has been studying in 9th Class. On 01.09.2021 at
about 07:30 PM, petitioner's daughter left the house without telling anyone.
Thereafter, the petitioner and his relatives tried to find her everywhere but
could not trace her. However, petitioner's daughter used to speak to one boy,
namely, Gopal, the petitioner has suspicion that the said man instigated his
minor daughter and kidnapped her. She further submits that after making
several requests, the respondents did not make efforts to find the daughter of
the petitioner. Further, the petitioner has filed representation dated 24.07.2024

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(Annexure P-3) in this regard to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana but no action has been taken so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 24.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl.A.G., Punjab, puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply copy of complete paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 24.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
