The present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in case FIR 49, dated 30.06.2023, under Sections 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station 'Women', Amritsar.

2. Learned State counsel based on status report dated 18.10.2023 filed by Ms. Khushbir Kaur, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Crime Against Women & Children, Amritsar City, submitted that fair and impartial investigation is carried out and Section 406 IPC was added. She further submitted that challan was presented on 28.09.2023 and now the case is fixed before the trial Court for 15.04.2024, for framing of charges.

3. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition, at this stage.

4. Consequently, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
