SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.389, dated 27.09.2023, under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC of the IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Hathin, District Palwal, Haryana.

This Court vide order dated 09.09.2024, while issuing notice of motion stayed the arrest of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Investigating Officer does not controvert the said fact and further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.



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Hence, in view of the admitted set of circumstances before this Court, the petitioner is hereby directed to be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing of personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS of which are reproduced below :-

‘When the High Court or the Court of Session makes a direction under sub-section (1), it may include such conditions in such directions in the light of the facts of the particular case, as it may think fit, including-

- (i) a condition that the person shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- (ii) a condition that the person shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;*
- (iii) a condition that the person shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court;*
- (iv) such other condition as may be imposed under sub-section (3) of section 480, as if the bail were granted under that section.’*

The petition in the aforesaid terms stand allowed.
