HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* to quash the impugned Bills (Annexure P-8 to P-72) issued by the Zonal Commissioner, Zone-B, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana (respondent No.4 herein).

1.1. A further prayer has been made for issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* for issuance of direction to respondent No.4 not to raise any exorbitant demand on account of sewerage.

1.2 Another prayer has been made to stay the recovery of the amount of each bill mentioned in Annexure P-8 to P-72, amounting to
