NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondent-department to release the arrears of revised pension/family pension to the petitioners on account of implementation of 6th Punjab Pay Commission, in view of judgment dated 25.07.2016 passed in CWP-12980 of 2015 titled ‘Mohinder Singh v. State of Punjab’.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners at the outset confines his prayer for deciding legal notice dated 19.03.2024 (Annexure P-4). He submits that at this stage, petitioners would be satisfied, if the said legal notice is considered and decided by passing a speaking order in a time-bound frame.
3. Notice of motion.



4. Mr. Rajesh Sehgal, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 and Mr. Saksham Dudeja, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.3 to 5.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.
6. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners in the present petition, respondent No.3 is directed to consider and decide the claim made by the petitioners in legal notice dated 19.03.2024 (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioners are found entitled, necessary benefits be released within a period of three weeks thereafter.
7. The petition stands disposed of.
