1. Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to respondents No.3 & 4 to remove the encroachment which has been done by the private-respondents No.5 to 8 upon the Panchayat land situated in Village Piproli, Tehsil Punhana, District Nuh.

2. Counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that there is a demarcation report (Annexure P-1) on the basis of which the necessary notices have been issued under Section 24(1) of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 (for short, the 'Act'). The necessary representation dated 29.04.2024 (Annexure P-3) has been filed before the Additional Deputy Commissioner, Nuh, followed up by another representation dated 31.05.2024 (Annexure P-4) to the Deputy Commissioner, Nuh but no action has been taken.

3. We have perused the demarcation report which go on to show that only respondents No.5 & 6 have been shown in occupation and there is no specific mention of respondents No.7 & 8 in the said report.
4. Faces with this situation, counsel for the petitioner does not press the petition qua respondents No.7 & 8 and the same is dismissed with liberty to get the fresh demarcation done and then take appropriate steps, if need be. Qua the other private respondents No.5 & 6, since having got the demarcation done and duly appended and a notice issued under Section 24(1) of the Act and request having been made to the official respondents bringing this fact to their notice, Mr.Mittal submits that necessary steps shall be taken by respondents No.3 & 4 on the request of the petitioner-Gram Panchayat, within a period of 2 months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
5. With the above assurance of the State Counsel, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
