Involving identical issues, the present writ petitions are being disposed of by a common order.

In brief, the petitioner has approached this Court for seeking release of the payment of the works executed by the petitioner involving NS item at the approved rate by the competent authority vide letter dated 28.04.2021 (Annexure P-4), which has been withheld by the respondents to analyze the rate again by constituting the committee vide letter dated 13.10.2021 (Annexure P-15).

Learned State counsel points out that there were as many as 25

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other writ petitions filed by the petitioner. The said writ petitions had been listed before the Division Bench of this Court. Vide order dated 01.03.2024 passed by the Division Bench in the above said batch of writ petitions including **CWP-6347-2022** titled as '**M/s Garg and Company Versus State of Haryana & others**', the parties have been granted liberty to appear before the Arbitrator for seeking redressal of their disputes since arbitration clause exists in these two writ petitions as well.

The above-said factual aspect is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner as well. The counsel were also asked to give their consent to the name of the agreed Arbitrator. They raised no objection to nomination of any Arbitrator by this Court.

The names of the Arbitrators appointed now were also suggested, they expressed there no objection to the same.

In the given circumstances, both these petitions stand disposed of with the consent of the parties, in terms of order dated 01.03.2024, passed in the batch of writ petitions including CWP-6347-2022, titled as '**M/s Garg and Company Versus State of Haryana & others**', as the lead case and terms and conditions provided therein.

Hon'ble Mr. Justice T.S. Dhindsa, Judge (Retd.) and Hon'ble Ms. Justice Nirmaljit Kaur, Judge (Retd.) are appointed as Arbitrator in CWP-22083-2021 and CWP-24074-2021 respectively.
