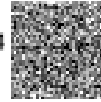

AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. The petitioner – Amandeep Kaur has filed petition under Section 483 of BNSS for grant of regular bail in FIR No.264 dated 09.07.2024, under Section 287, 49, 308(4), 111, 61(2) of BNS, 2023 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Ladwa, District Kurukshetra.

2. As per the facts of case, Ankush Goyal filed written complaint alleging that he was running EDU SKOPE Studies Centre in Ladwa and is vice-president of Bharatiya Janata Party. On 08.07.2024, he was sleeping in the house along with his family. At about 11:05 PM, door bell outside his house rang and from inside he saw two young boys were standing on the road outside the gate, one boy was on motorcycle and other boy holding a pistol in his hand was continuously firing in the air to spread terror. Entire incident was captured in CCTV camera. He could identify the said

boys on seeing. With these allegations, present FIR has been registered.

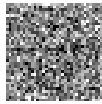
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Later on during investigation, present petitioner was also arrested.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner argued that petitioner is a household lady having no concern with the said occurrence. As per the facts and the investigation carried out by the police, shots were fired by co-accused Varun alias Ashu alias Binda and Manpreet alias Mani. Apart from them one Sonu was also involved in the said occurrence. Present petitioner was apprehended on account of some misunderstanding. Complainant Ankush Goyal has given his affidavit (Annexure P-2) clarifying that she had no role to play in the said crime. She is behind the bars since 13.07.2024. She is ready to abide by the terms of bail order. Therefore, her regular bail petition may be allowed.

4. Bail petition was opposed by learned counsel representing State. Detailed status report has been filed. It is pointed out that in CCTV footage co-accused Manpreet alias Mani and Varun alias Ashu alias Binda were clearly seen firing shots. In fact the entire occurrence took place at the instance of present petitioner whose husband had gone to America and in order to extract money said occurrence took place with the help of co-accused Sonu Bakali, Manpreet alias Mani and Varun alias Ashu alias Binda. Bail application filed by petitioner was rightly declined by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Kurukeshtra. It is confirmed that present petitioner is not involved in any other case.

5. I have considered the arguments and have gone through the record. As per the facts narrated above, only two boys were seen standing on the road and one boy on the motorcycle holding pistol and firing shots towards the house of complainant to create terror. Entire incident was



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recorded in CCTV footage and later on accused persons were identified. Present petitioner was not present on the spot. Learned counsel for complainant confirmed that complainant has given affidavit that he has no objection if Amandeep Kaur is granted bail. Even otherwise, Amandeep Kaur has already joined the investigation and she is behind the bars. She is ready to abide by the terms of bail order.

Considering the aforesaid factual position, regular bail petition filed by petitioner – Amandeep Kaur is allowed. She is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Judge concerned.
