1. Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to release the payment to the petitioners against the material supplied by them to respondent No.4.
2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that with regard to their grievance, the petitioners have submitted various representations but the respondents have neither paid the outstanding dues to the petitioners nor have they taken any action upon the said representations.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Ms. Niharika Sharma, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State and she prays for some time to complete the instructions and file response, if necessary.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners, however, contends that he would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.3, is directed to consider and decide the representations of the petitioners, by passing speaking order(s) in a time bound manner.

6. Learned State counsel submits that she has no objection to the request made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Accordingly, in view of the above; with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.3-Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Block Dharamkot at Kot Isse Khan, District Moga to consider and decide the representations by passing reasoned and speaking order(s) after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

8. Needless to mention that upon considering the said representation, if any amount is found due and payable to the petitioners, the same shall be disbursed in favour of the petitioners within a further period of three months.

9. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
