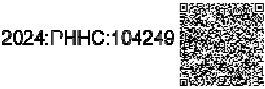
NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for quashing the order dated 02.08.2024 (Annexure P-6), whereby petitioner has been transferred from Municipal Council, Gurdaspur, to Municipal Council, Patti (Tarn Taran).

2. On 09.08.2024 following order was passed: -

“Challenge in the present petition is to the transfer order dated 02.08.2024 (Annexure P-6) whereby petitioner, who is working as Superintendent, has been transferred from Municipal Council, Gurdaspur, to Municipal Council, Patti.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced a copy of the letter dated 05.08.2024 written by the Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Patti,



wherein it has been stated that there is no post of Superintendent in Municipal Council, Patti, and, therefore, there is no budgetary provision for the said post and consequently, the petitioner be posted in some other Municipal Committee.

Learned State counsel seeks adjournment to get instructions on this aspect.

Adjourned to 13.08.2024.”

- 3. Learned State counsel has produced a copy of order dated 12.08.2024, whereby now the petitioner has been transferred as Superintendent, Municipal Council, Nawanshahr, against vacant post.
- 4. In this view of the matter, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw this petition with liberty to challenge the order dated 12.08.2024.
- 5. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
