NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 11.08.1992 (Annexure P-1), whereby the services of late Sita Ram, who went missing w.e.f. 04.05.1989, has been terminated, further issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the service benefits as well as family pension of late Sita Ram, who has been declared as presumed to be dead vide judgment and decree dated 09.05.2022 (Annexure P-2), and also to consider the claim of petitioner No.2 for compassionate appointment.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the claim of the petitioners for grant of family pension, G.P.F., ex-gratia and leave

encashment is under process and the necessary benefits shall be released within a period of two months.

3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, the instant writ petition has been rendered infructuous and disposed of accordingly.
