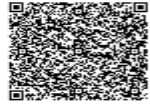

AMARJOT BHATTI, J. (Oral)

1. Petitioners – Kirna Devi and Sarnam Singh have filed criminal writ petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India for direction to official respondents to protect life and liberty of petitioners from the hands of private respondent No.4 Sushma who is threatening and harassing petitioners along with her associates and further threatening to involve them in false criminal case.

2. Notice of petition was given to respondents. Official respondent Nos.2 and 3 have filed status report. It is pointed out that on the complaint of respondent No.4, FIR No.468 dated 30.07.2024 under Sections 354A (1)

(i) IPC at Police Station Krishna Gate, Thanesar, Kurukshetra has been

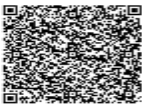


registered. Statement of Sushma is recorded which is Annexure R-1. She has levelled allegations against petitioners. Copy of aforesaid FIR is also placed on record as Annexure R-2.

3. Respondent No.4 appeared through her counsel Mr. Ivneet Singh Pabla and filed detailed reply through Registry which is taken on record. It is pointed out that in-fact petitioners were harassing respondent No.4 and in order to save their skin in the aforesaid FIR, false petition has been filed by petitioners. It is alleged that at present both petitioners are residing in the house peacefully.

4. I have considered the arguments and have gone through the record carefully. Petitioner No.1 Kirna Devi is the sister in-law (*jethani*) of respondent No.4 Sushma whereas petitioner No.2 is the father-in-law of respondent No.4. It is confirmed that petitioners and respondent No.4 are residing in the same house. On the complaint of respondent No.4 FIR No.468 dated 30.07.2024 was registered under Sections 354A (1) (i) IPC at Police Station Krishna Gate, Thanesar, Kurukshetra. Present petitioners were not permitted to enter the house. Now it is confirmed that with the intervention of police, both petitioners have returned to the house on 10.08.2024. Therefore, at this stage, petitioners and respondent No.4 are residing peacefully. There is no threat perception or allegations of harassment. Therefore, present writ petition filed under Article 226 Constitution of India seeking protection is rendered infructuous and it is accordingly disposed of.

5. This order will have no bearing on FIR No.468 dated 30.07.2024 (*supra*) which will be decided on its own merits.



6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
