The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for directing the respondents to take action against the private respondents in view of complaints dated 14.03.2019 (Annexure P-2) and dated 27.03.2019 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this petition has been rendered infructuous as possession over the land has already been taken by the Gram Panchayat and cause of action does not survive in that eventuality.
