1. The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari seeking quashing of order dated 01.08.2023 (Annexure P-1) vide which he was declined the relief of regular parole by the District Magistrate, Rewari.
2. Learned counsel, at the outset, submits that he would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to the official respondents to consider his case for parole, afresh.
3. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – District Magistrate, Rewari to look into the request of the petitioner for grant of the concession of regular parole to him, afresh in accordance with law at the earliest.
