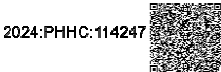
TRIBHUVAN DAHIYA, J. (ORAL)

The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant interest on the delayed payment of arrears, which were due from the date of actual promotion as Senior Librarian on 17.08.2010, and have been paid only on 20.10.2019.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case they are permitted to make a fresh representation before the respondents raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a specified period

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Krishan K. Chahal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioners within three weeks from today, the same will be decided by respondent no.2-Director General, Higher Education Haryana, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within six months of receiving the representation.



5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioners has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
