Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellants through video conferencing has stated that the matter can be amicably settled if Insurance-Company is ready to give Rs. 5,50,000/- over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal.

Learned counsel appearing for Insurance Company has agreed to the grant of said amount of Rs. 5,50,000/- over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal.

Keeping in view the aforesaid statements made by learned counsel for the appellants as well as the statement made by learned counsel representing the respondent–Insurance Company that the matter has been settled, a sum of Rs. 5,50,000/- (Five Lakhs Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellants.

Accordingly, we **dispose of** this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.5.50,000/- (Five Lakhs Fifty Thousand Only) in the name of appellants with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before six weeks in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat

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counsel/representative of the respondent–Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.

All pending application(s), if any, shall stand closed.
