The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in cross case bearing DDR No.32 dated 19.11.2021 under Sections 323, 324, 451, 447, 511, 506, 427, 148 and 149 IPC (Sections 420, 468, 471, 201 and 120-B IPC added later on) in FIR No.239 dated 18.11.2021 under Sections 323, 324, 506, 427, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Sahnewal, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 18.08.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 18.08.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

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In view of the above, the interim order dated 18.08.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
