On 25.01.2024, the following order was passed by this
Court:-

“The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners for appointment to the posts of Multi-Purpose Health Worker (Male) in the dependent of Backward Class category and for directing the respondents to appoint the petitioners to the said posts.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3 submits that there is no need for filing any written statement on behalf of respondent No.3 and the case can be proceeded further on the basis of written statement filed on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2.

Written statement filed on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 is already on record. In para 4 of the written statement it has been stated that the petitioners

are not eligible for appointment as they obtained marks ranging from 368 to 388 in the written test and the cut off under Backward Class category is 390 marks.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners seeks an adjournment to address arguments.

Adjourned to 09.02.2024.

Since the marks obtained by the petitioners are between 368 to 388 and the cut-off marks under Backward Class Category is 390 marks, therefore, the petitioners have no right to claim the appointment.

Dismissed.
