1. Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of *certiorari* quashing the order dated 19.05.2021 (Annexure P-5) only to the extent whereby gratuity payable to the petitioner has been limited to Rs.10 lakhs. Further, writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to pay the balance amount of gratuity of Rs.1,95,182/- along with interest @ 18% from the date of retirement till its actual payment and to pay the arrears of revised gratuity, revised leave encashment along with interest @ 18% per annum from the date of notification of the Punjab Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2021 till its actual payment.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the relief claimed in the present petition has been granted by the respondents, therefore, instant petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Disposed of accordingly.
