1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.429 dated 25.10.2016 under Sections 307, 452, 354, 148 and 149 IPC, 1860, and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Division A, District Amritsar City, Annexure P-1, alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.
2. Learned State counsel, at the very outset submits that the cancellation report submitted before the jurisdictional Court has not been accepted by the Court concerned and the investigating agency has been directed for further investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he would be satisfied, in case, a time bound direction is issued to the investigating agency to conclude the investigation in time bound manner as investigation is pending for the last 08 years, in view of the fact that the cancellation report was submitted in the year 2017, which was not accepted by learned jurisdictional Court for want of service of respondent No.2.

5. Be that as it may, in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the investigating officer to conclude the investigation within a period of 03 months.
6. Disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stand(s) disposed of.
